for a State of Rhode Island Assent to: Install a meteorological (MET) tower to obtain wind and other scientific measurements, the installation is temporary and is expected to last 2 years subject to stipulations in the lease from the Town of New Shoreham. The tower and all other elements installed (block and fencing) will be removed and the site restored at the conclusion of the measurements.

Plans of the proposed work may be seen at the CRMC office in Wakefield.


In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act (Chapter 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws) you may request a hearing on this matter.

You are advised that if you have good reason to enter protests against the proposed work it is your privilege to do so. It is expected that objectors will review the application and plans thoroughly, visit site of proposed work if necessary, to familiarize themselves with the conditions and cite what law or laws, if any, would in their opinion be violated by the work proposed.

If you desire to protest, you must attend the scheduled hearing and give sworn testimony. A notice of the time and place of such hearing will be furnished you as soon as possible after receipt of your request for hearing. If you desire to request a hearing, to receive consideration, it should be in writing and be received at this office on or before May 21, 2009.

Deepwater investigated locating the Met Tower at Potential Met Site #1, near the Block Island North Light, but soon learned that the land was a nesting ground for the *Piping Plover* and that it was also immediately adjacent to a gull rookery run by US Fish and Wildlife Service. In order to avoid impacts to the local avian species, Deepwater chose to install the met tower at Potential Met Site #4. Figure 6 below shows the location of the Met Tower and guy wires (shown in red).
