for a State of Rhode Island Assent to construct and maintain: an aquaculture operation to grow oysters using two sites in Quonochontaug Pond. One site will be a 0.79 acre year round area to grow oysters in floating bags. The second site proposed is a 0.13 acre area for temporary winter storage of oysters in cages from November 1 to May 1. In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act (Chapter 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws) you may request a hearing on this matter.

You are advised that if you have good reason to enter protests against the proposed work it is your privilege to do so. It is expected that objectors will review the application and plans thoroughly, visit site of proposed work if necessary, to familiarize themselves with the conditions and cite what law or laws, if any, would in their opinion be violated by the work proposed.

If you desire to protest, you must attend the scheduled hearing and give sworn testimony. A notice of the time and place of such hearing will be furnished you as soon as possible after receipt of your request for hearing. If you desire to request a hearing, to receive consideration, it should be in writing (**with your correct mailing address, e-mail address and valid contact number**) and be received at this office on or before October 23, 2015.

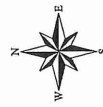


PROPOSED
