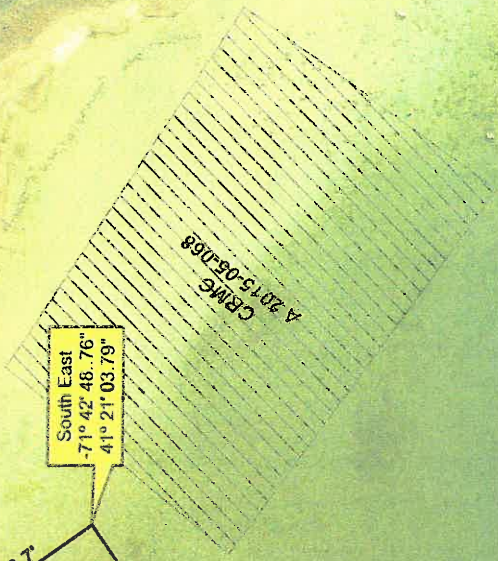
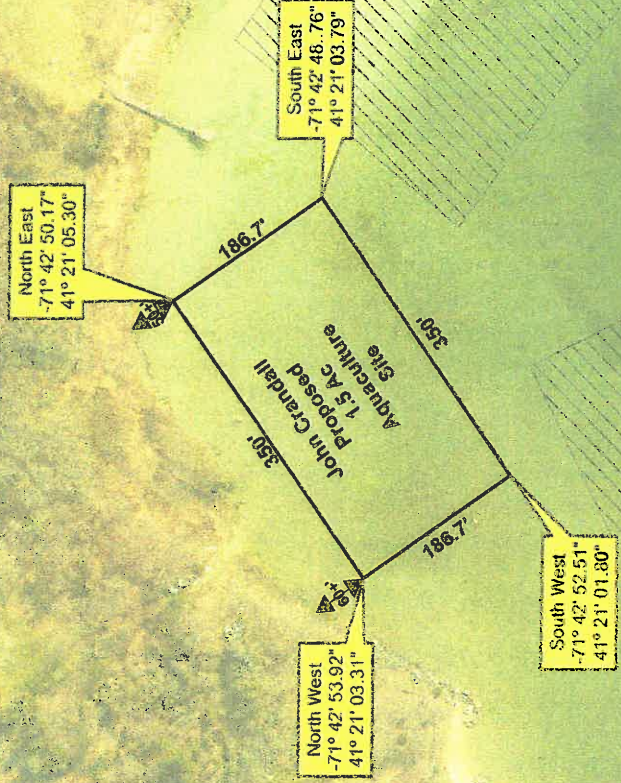
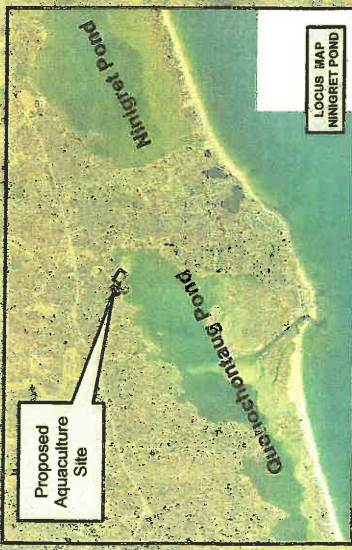
Plans of the proposed work may be seen at the CRMC office in Wakefield.
