for a State of Rhode Island Assent to construct and maintain: two (2) boat lifts (1200lb and 25K lb) onto an existing residential boating facility and to reconfigure an existing ramp and float further north. Three (3) new tie-off pilings are also proposed ~2' further seaward, which will increase the total facility length to ~175' seaward of the cited MLW mark. The pilings require an additional 2' length variance from RICRMP Section 1.3.1(D) standards.
