for a State of Rhode Island Assent to construct and maintain: A residential boating facility consisting of a 3' x 12' upland ramp, a 4' x 85' fixed timber pier, a 3' x 30' aluminum gangway and an 8' x 18.75' (150sf) terminal float. The facility is to extend 75' seaward of the cited MLW mark, requiring a 25' length variance to Redbook 650-RICR-20-00-01 Section 1.3.1(D)(11)(I).

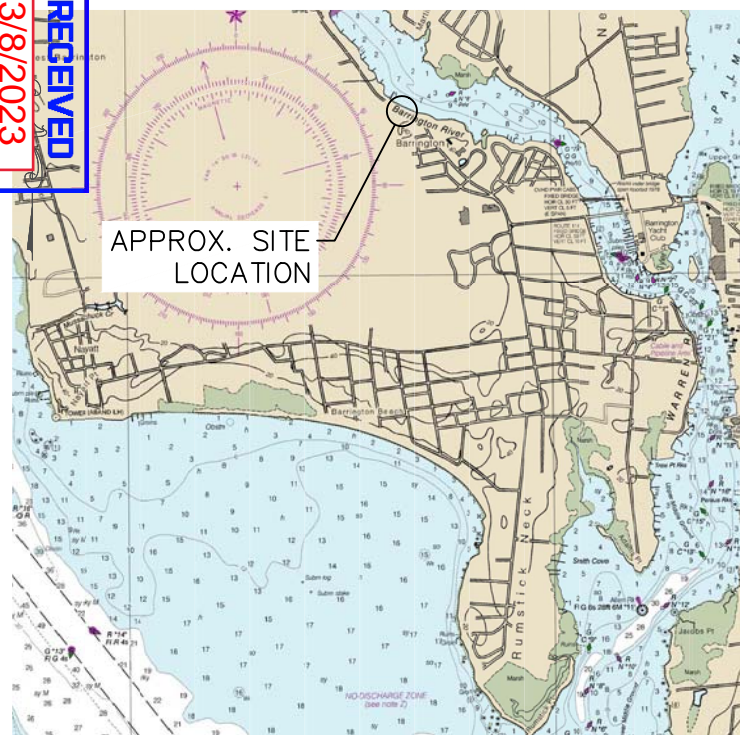

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT BEGIN CONSTRUCTION IN ANY SUCH AFFECTED AREA UNTIL THE DISCREPANCY HAS BEEN RESOLVED BY THE CONTRACTOR AND APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.

7. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO OBTAIN THE SURVEY SUPPORT NEEDED TO COMPLETE THE WORK, INCLUDING STAKEOUT, TO ENSURE THE WORK IS COMPLETED CONSISTENT WITH PROJECT PLANS AND ASSOCIATED REGULATORY APPROVALS. CONTRACTOR TO PRESERVE SURVEY BENCHMARKS.
8. ALL MATERIAL STORAGE SHALL BE DONE VIA BARGE IF NECESSARY. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT ALL WETLANDS AND ASSOCIATED COASTAL RESOURCES FROM INTRUSION BY TURBID WATERS, CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS, CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT, OR PERSONNEL DURING ALL WORK ACTIVITIES.
9. DAMAGE TO ANY PROPERTY, PRIVATE OR OF PUBLIC TRUST, OCCURRING DURING THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE CONTRACTOR, SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR AND SHALL BE REPAIRED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE OWNER AT THE EXPENSE OF THE CONTRACTOR.

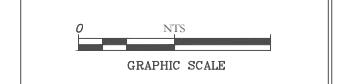

2. TIDAL BENCHMARKS OBTAINED FROM NOAA ONLINE VERTICAL DATUM TRANSFORMATION TOOL
3. STILLWATER ELEVATIONS WERE TAKEN DIRECTLY FROM A DETAILED STORM SURGE STUDY DOCUMENTED IN UPDATING TIDAL PROFILES FOR THE NEW ENGLAND COASTLINE, PREPARED BY FEMA (FEMA 2008). THIS STORM SURGE STUDY WAS COMPLETED IN NOVEMBER 2011. SWELS WERE LINEARLY INTERPOLATED TO ALL COASTAL TRANSECTS THROUGHOUT BRISTOL COUNTY.
