

Program Logistics: Frequently-Asked Questions

Question: Who Can Participate in the Rhode Island Clean Marina Program?

Marinas, Boatyards, Yacht Clubs, Boating Centers, and other Waterfront Facilities

Question: How Long Is A Certification Valid?

A certification will last five (5) years from the time of designation. In the fifth year, your facility will be contacted to schedule a recertification

Question: How Much Does it Cost to be Certified?

There will be no application fee for certification at this time

Question: What Happens upon Completion of the Certification Process?

All certified facilities will receive official certificate, flag and materials for promotion.

Recognition Ceremony to be held Fall 2021, additional promotional opportunities forthcoming.
