

The issue is that the Dock/SAV regulations state that when over SAV, a facility must terminate at -5. There is room for the facility to terminate at -5 and meet Burdick and Short design requirements. A dinghy lift can be allowed – however over SAV it can only be a tender lift and no larger than 1200lbs. The tie off piles cannot be allowed, as a facility over SAV can only be utilized as a "touch and go" facility – no docking over SAV is permitted.

Attached is a mock up done by the client for discussion purposes, applicant's additions/ alterations are in red.

The proposal is to shorten the pier from that plan that was presented by applicant and generally in keeping with CRMC's counter proposal plan but slightly longer

Applicant would like to keep the pier a bit longer to avoid the need to remove the Rock pile / dredging and thereby preserve additional depth to allow the vessel to tie up inside the finger pier if the sea state so dictates.

To be clear, the intention is for a single vessel (temporary tie up) and dingy so they may reach the vessel on its mooring in Newport Harbor

It has been some time since we discussed this file.

I'd like to circle back with you now that I have heard more from my Client. I recognize that your office sent a letter requesting action on the file before May 25, 2022 lest it be considered abandoned.

When we spoke last your office proposed a shortening of the Fixed pier and dredging/ removal of the rock pile to gain sufficient depth and mitigate shadowing form the fixed pier.

My client has asked that I speak with you regarding an "in between option that would still shorten the pier but remove the need for dredging/removal of the rock pile.




