### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with and pursuant to the provisions of the "Administrative Procedures Act", (Chapter 42-35 et. seq. of the General Laws of Rhode Island), and the Rules and Regulations of the Coastal Resources Management Council, a public hearing will be held relative to Title 46, Chapter 23, Section 6 of the Rhode Island General Laws of 1956, as amended on a potential **Right-of-Way located in the Town of Bristol, RI.**

The proposed Right-of-Way (ROW) runs from the end of Old Ferry Road, on the southern tip of Bristol, across a short rocky shore to the water under the Mount Hope Bridge.

The ROW is located within an untaxed parcel of land the Bristol Tax Assessor designates as an easement. On either side of the ROW are Assessor's Plat 164C, Lot 2, and Plat 167, Lots 41-43, all of which the Tax Assessor indicates are owned by Roger Williams University.


