for a State of Rhode Island Assent to construct and maintain: Modification to a pre-existing residential boating facility. The non-standard permitted conditions are a 38"x 65' timber fixed pier with cribbing and bump-out, a 31" x 12' access ramp, and three 5'x 10' (150sf) terminal floats, extending ~70-75' seaward of the toe of bank. The existing non-standard conditions are a similar fixed pier/cribbing, a reconfigured larger bump-out, an shorter access ramp and two 15'x5' (150sf) terminal floats. The proposed layout is the same fixed pier/cribbing. Bump-out size, 3'x20' access ramp and two terminal floats 4'x13.5'x4'x24'(150sf). The facility is to extend 48' seaward of the cited MLW mark, slightly reduced in overall length (68') from the toe of bank. No variances are required for the proposed work.

It is expected that objectors will review the application and plans thoroughly, visit site of proposed work if necessary, to familiarize themselves with the conditions and cite what law or laws, if any, would in their opinion be violated by the work proposed.

If you desire to protest, you must attend the scheduled hearing and give sworn testimony. A notice of the time and place of such hearing will be furnished you as soon as possible after receipt of your request for hearing. If you desire to request a hearing, to receive consideration, it should be in writing (**with your correct mailing address, e-mail address and valid contact number**) and be received at this office on or before **December 29, 2024**.
