I am in-house counsel for PPL Services Corporation, and I am submitting this letter on behalf of the Narragansett Electric Company (TNEC), a subsidiary of PPL Corporation. TNEC is submitting this letter with respect to the Category B application filing referenced above by Revolution Wind, LLC (Revolution Wind) with the Coastal Resources Management Council (CRMC) related to the proposed construction and operation of two 23-Mile Submarine Export Cables through the West Passage of Narragansett Bay to the Cable Landing Location in North Kingstown and Other Associated Facilities.

TNEC is sending this letter to CRMC to acknowledge that, although final negotiations regarding certain details are on-going, TNEC will provide Revolution Wind with the land rights needed for the above-identified application, consistent with Energy Facility Siting Board (EFSB) Order No. 154, issued in *In re: Revolution Wind, LLC Application to Construct a Major Energy Facility, Docket No. S.B. 2021-01*.
