The Rhode Island Historical Preservation and Heritage Commission (RIHPHC) staff has reviewed the information that you provided for the above-referenced project. The Quonset Development Corporation is proposing the development of the Quonset Multi-Modal Off-shore Wind Transport & training Center (QMT²C) at the Quonset Business Park. The project may be funded in whole or part by a grant from the U.S. Economic Development Administration.

The QMT²C will consist of a 60,000 square foot building and will be in a part of the business park that is not sensitive for historical resources. Based on our review of available information, it is the conclusion of the RIHPHC that the proposed project will have no adverse effect on historic properties.
