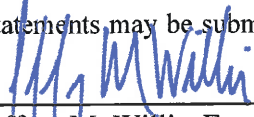

Hi Amy – thanks for following up on this. I was going to bring this up as we got closer to the 20-day cutoff, I was assuming that CRMC would be providing us with an updated Notice of Public Hearing for posting in the ProJo since the language marked “Continued” in the email provided to us on the 24th still indicates that the proposed fishing pier is on the eastern side of the Barrington River. To be clear, we held off on posting the notice sent to us on 4/9 since we knew we would be making changes to the fishing pier location. I’m not sure if you were aware of that.

Since it has not yet been posted in the ProJo I was thinking that it would cleanest to simply modify the Notice of Public Hearing to include the May 28th hearing date as well as stating that the proposed pier is on the western side.

However, if we need to post the old notice as well as all the public notice revision provided to us on the 24th we can do that. Let us know what you think.

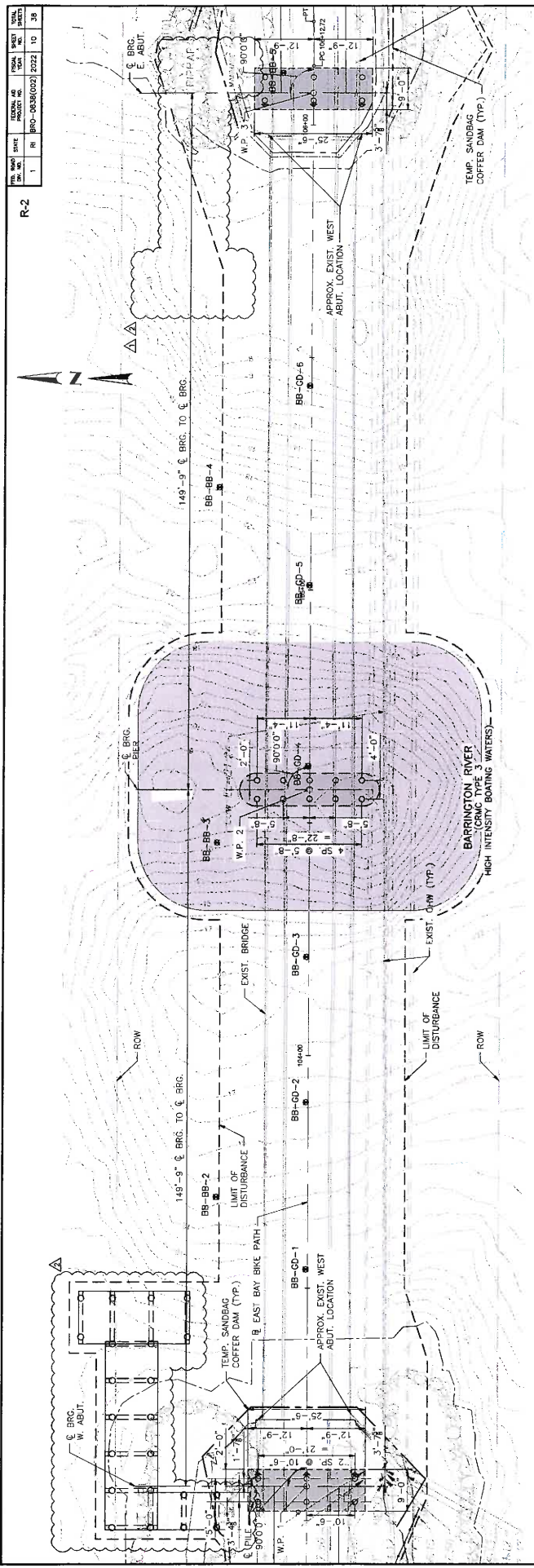

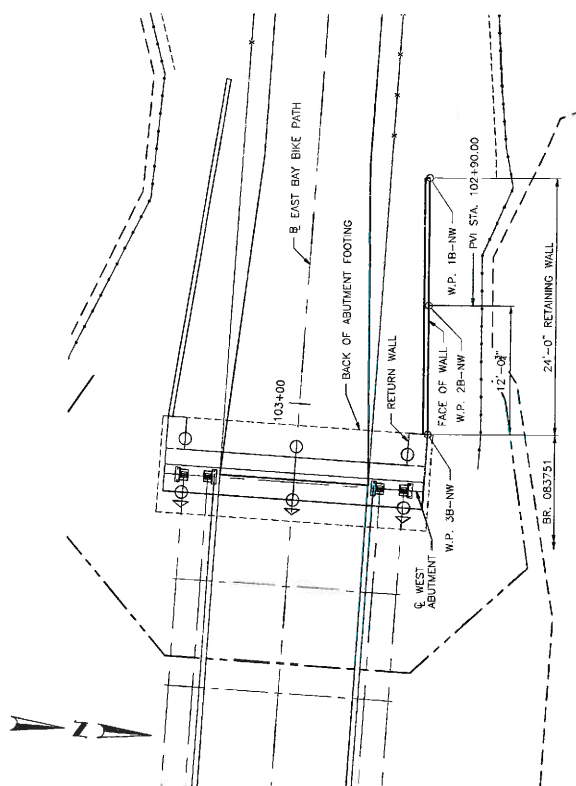
EAST ABUTMENT ELEVATION

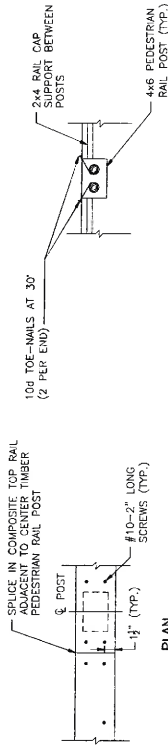

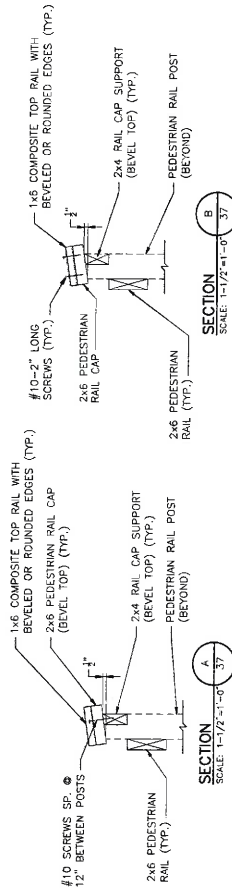

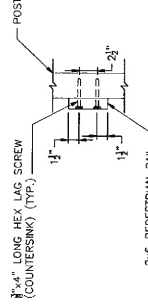
PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE APPROACH RAIL (PBAR) ELEVATION

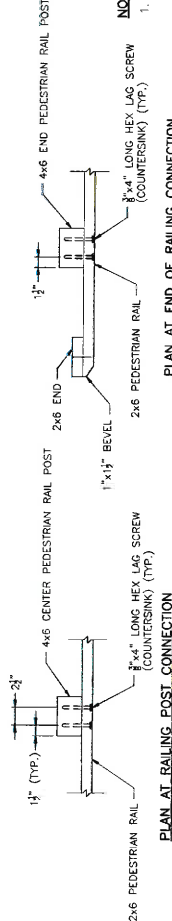
