The completed revetment will start east of Edda Ave and end east of Alice Ave. The project was approved under a Maintenance Certification Assent on April 15, 2023 (CRMC File No. M2024-01-097) with the stipulation that a Category B Assent application be filed and an Assent granted within one calendar year of the date of issuance of the Maintenance Certification Assent.
