CRMC Portion of *the project extends from Boyd's Lane Portsmouth to Riverside Dr, Tiverton*. Project will result in the permanent alteration of 548ft² of Coastal Wetland and 101ft² of Freshwater Wetland. Project Requires a Special Exception to 650-RICR-00-1.2.2(C)(1)(d) and (C)(2)(b). In accordance with §1.3.1(L)(5), 1, 815ft² of mitigation wetland will be created, exceeding the 2:1 replacement requirement. Alteration to Freshwater Wetlands falls under Exemption 650-RICR-00-9.6.3


