CRMC,

I am writing to oppose the approval of these two applications as they seek to approve the taking of a private waterway for a private commercial use.

- * These applications will impede Navigation, Recreation, and fisheries uses of Point Judith Pond.

- * URI and Camp Fuller have used these waters for decades for sailing, canoeing and kayaking!

- * These water are six feet deep at MLW and 11 feet deep at MHW. Perfect depth for all recreational uses.

- *CRMC has stated for several years that the Vanhemelrijck lease would be the final lease approval for Point Judith Pond.

- *The 5% max lease percentage of oyster farms neglects to consider the Government marked channels, mooring fields, and sand bars that are not navigable at low tide, hence reducing recreational usage.

- *These applicants, and current owners of these leases, Cedar Island Oyster Co, and John & Cindy West, have been actively marketing these leases as "for sale" for at a minimum of one year and are using this application, to enhance their selling price, using The CRMC as a tool to enhance the sale price. It is not the CRMC's , or any governments job, to aide and abet a private transaction. The fact that this lease has been for sale is common knowledge to the Oyster Farming Community!

Stay out of it CRMC.
